The Challenge

Initial Transition Away from SchoolStatus

When Dr. Jeff Seeton joined Lake Worth ISD as a Principal, the district was using SchoolStatus Connect for their school-home communications. However, a decision was made by the district's leadership to switch to a different communication platform.


The Solution


Initial Transition Away from SchoolStatus
